Note from the Administration

Thanksgiving is a time when most Americans are grateful for the blessings they have received. Such an expression of gratitude is fitting. Rather than convey it just one day each year, we need to be thankful every day. We receive blessings on a daily basis. In Matthew 6:11, the prayer of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus taught us to pray to God so that God might "Give us this day our daily bread." Verse 4 continues, "For every creature of God is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with thanksgiving."



Our thanksgiving should focus on God for the blessings we have because God is the essence of all good things. James 1:17 states, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning." "God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands. Nor is He worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed anything since He gives to all life, breath, and all things" (Acts 17:24-25). Many people will be thankful on Thanksgiving Day, yet forget to be thankful to God. Since "all things" are given from God, we should thank Him for the blessings we enjoy.

In the story of the ten lepers, only one of them thanked Him for their healing. Jesus asked, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" (Luke 17:17-18). Those who receive blessings from God should be thankful to Him.

Christ sustains us spiritually (Eph. 1:3) to enable us to overcome sin and death so that we may live eternally. Christians ought to be passionate in expressing thanksgiving to God for those material blessings that sustain physical life for us to carry

out His will. There is no better way to show gratitude to God for all that He has graciously given to us than by living in obedience to His will. Thanksgiving Day and every day let us give thanks to God.

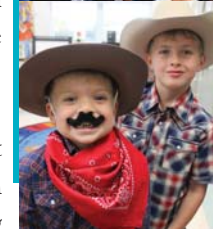


Join us for two special Christmas Programs this year in the CCM Sanctuary.
